#### Management

#### Directions:

- 1. From Phoenix take Loop 202 East.
- 2. Exit Country Club Drive and head South to Main St.
- 3. Turn Left (East) on Main St. and travel a half mile until you come to Sirrine/Centennial Way
- 4. Turn Right (South) on Sirrine/Centennial Way
- 5. Take your first right into the service drive behind the Sunrise Bank. Follow the drive as it curves to the left.

#### Load In Access:

- The Dobson Lecture Hall is located on the basement level of the Mesa Contemporary Arts Museum, located at the Southeast corner of Main and Center.
- Load in access is either the curb cut on the service drive between 55 East Main and the Sunrise Bank, from the parking lot located at the Northeast corner or Center and 1<sup>st</sup> St, or a curb cut on Center between Main and 1<sup>st</sup> St.
  - Ask your rental coordinator for the appropriate load in location.
- Once vehicles are unloaded, they will need to be moved into a parking spot.
  - Ask your rental coordinator for the appropriate parking locations.
- If you need your vehicle closer to the lecture hall for load in or load out purposes, you must prearrange this with your rental contact.
- Absolutely no vehicles are allowed on the Shadow Walk (sidewalk in the middle of campus) without a security escort. Security can be reached at 480-644-6630.

#### Storage:

 Preshow or post-show storage is not available at the Mesa Arts Center. All items must arrive at your scheduled load in time and leave at load out. The Mesa Arts Center is not responsible for items left behind.



#### **Audio**

#### Lectern Audio

• There is a gooseneck microphone that is attached to the podium. This microphone is suitable for the Dobson Lecture Hall's size.

#### **Laptop Audio**

• There is an 1/8" connector and an HDMI connector on the podium. The audio system will work with either option.

#### Other Gear (subject to availability)

- Wireless microphones (lavaliers and handhelds) are available upon request.
  - o The use of these may result in additional fees for labor and equipment.
  - The use of these microphones must be prearranged with your rental contact prior to your event.

#### Lighting

#### **Lighting Options**

• The lighting is dimmable and variable depending on the event's needs. The lighting can be controlled from a panel at the lecture hall's door.

#### Video

#### **Video Options**

- If a laptop is being used for the video portions, there is an HDMI connector and a VGA connector on the podium. The video system will work either of these options.
  - o If the laptop the client is proving is a Mac, the client must supply an adapter to adapt from the Mac video port to either VGA or HDMI.
- If a DVD or Blue Ray is being used, please provide your rental coordinator with the media.
- Screen size is roughly 14'-0 wide by 7'-0 tall.
